



Getting Started with Decorative Street Signs

The Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) sets standards for road signs. Many municipalities also have their own regulations for sizes and types of signs. We strongly recommend that you contact your local authority to make sure you comply with all requirements. Below are some questions you may find helpful as you get started.
